We've also thrown in a number of other interesting things to find along the way, just for fun.

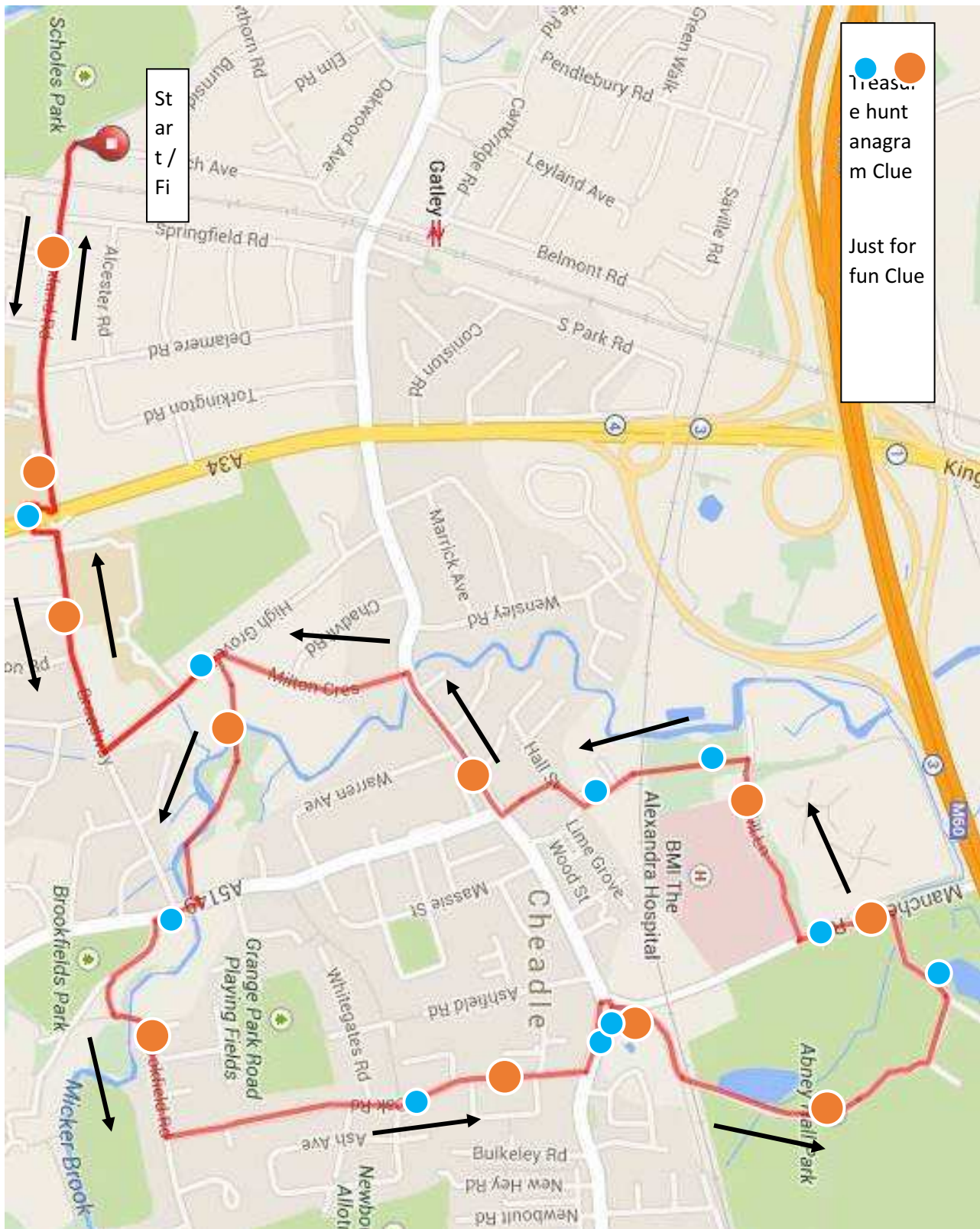
As you collect the letters, (there are 12 in total) make a note of them here:

Route:

From the end of Beech Avenue, follow the bridlepath underneath the railway and on to Foxland Road.

Clue for anagram letter #1

This part of Gatley is truly Super, find the first in the parade.



Find the 5th letter of the 2nd word
And fill in your anagram

Route:

Follow Foxland Road to the very end, near the A34 (Kingsway).

Clue for anagram letter #2

Finding this logo will focus your pupils.



Find the 3rd letter of the 1st word
And fill in your anagram

Route:

Through the path and right to follow the underpass to the other side of the A34 (Kingsway).

Route:

Cross Broadway (using the pelican crossing), and follow Broadway towards Cheadle

Clue for anagram letter #3

You'll find this sign up in the air, children wait for transport there, The big yellow clue that must be found, can only be found on the ground.



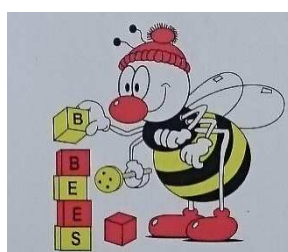
Find the 2nd letter of the 2nd word

Route:

Turn left along High Grove Road

Route:

Immediately before Milton Crescent, turn right along the footpath,
Cross over the bridge and follow the path straight ahead.

Where the cobbles start, stop and park,
Look for words carved into bark



Find the 1st of 2 initials, above NAT
And fill in your anagram

Route:

Follow the cobbled path and dirt track to the end where it meets
Wilmslow road.

Use the crossing island to cross Wilmslow Road and turn right.

Turn left into Brookfield Park.

After 100 yards follow the footpath to the left, cross over the brook
and onto Brookfield Road.

Which road will this sign lead you too?



Find the 1st letter, 2nd word
of the road it leads to.
Fill in your anagram

Route:

Follow Brookfield Road for 300 yards and turn left onto Oak Road

Continue along Oak Road.

Clue for anagram letter #6

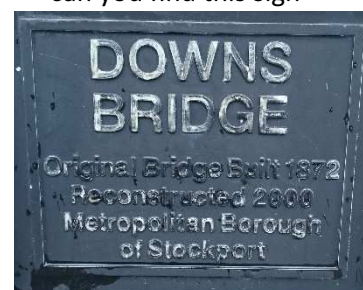
Find this Regent letter box, the clue is at the top of the white sign

Follow Oak Road to the very end and turn left onto Stockport Road.
Please dismount from your bikes and use the pavement.
Cross Stockport Road towards Manchester at the traffic lights

When you find the year you'll find the sign for this literary clue.



Find the 4th letter of the 1st word.
Fill in your anagram

Route:

Turn right immediately before Maxwell Car Sales garage.
Follow the narrow road for several hundred yards, go under the railway
and follow the lane into Abney Park to the notice board.

Find the notice board and find these flowers,
These people are not enemies of Abney Park, what are they?



Find the 6th letter of the first word
And fill in your anagram

Route:

Follow the footpath straight on, all the way to Abney Hall

Route:

Once past Abney Hall, turn left onto the single track road that leads out of Abney Park.

Clue for anagram letter #9

At the gate to Abney Hall, find this symbol on a sign for the valley.



Find the 7th letter of the 1st word

Route:

Turn left out of Abney Hall and cross over Manchester Road using the pelican crossing. Follow the road back towards Cheadle and turn right onto Mill Lane.

Continue along Mill Lane (with the hospital on your left).

Clue for anagram letter #10

The people in this building look after muscle and bone,
But where is this symbol shown?



Find 1st letter of the 1st word
And fill in your anagram

Route:

At the end of Mill Lane turn sharp left through the trees and follow the cycle route sign towards Cheadle, go under the railway bridge.

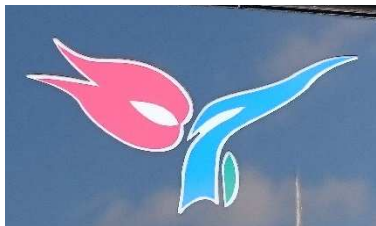


Route:

Follow Brook Street for 200 yards and turn right on Hall Street, then left along a passage way between the Church and the White Hart pub

Turn right onto Cheadle High street towards Gatley.
Cross the road at the pelican crossing.

Clue:

Find this sign where you can get a trim and a clip,
Look for white words on a purple strip.



Find the 5th letter of the 4st word
And fill in your anagram
